The meeting will take place at the Fisheries Sciences building at the University of Washington, Seattle, indicated on the map below ([see also interactive map](#)). Take the University of Washington station or the U District station exit (The brand new U District station is about 5 minutes closer to both Willow Hall and the Meeting Venue). If staying at UW Housing, please proceed to check-in at Willow Hall for your room keys and room assignment. The venue is a pleasant 15 min walk downhill from Willow Hall. Uber, Lyft or taxi service (206-523-3333) are alternatives for crossing campus between light rail station, lodging and the venue. We may be able to arrange small van transportation between housing and the venue if needed.
